Daniel Padilla and Kathryn Bernardo, for the first time, are speaking up about the real score on their relationship

Six fruitful years have passed since their tandem had come to be christened as "KathNiel", but more than the professional relationship that Daniel and Kathryn have been nurturing is a deeper personal connection that they share—the kind of connection that is not easy to come by, especially in the chaotic world of showbiz. In fact, their connection is so special that even their petname for each other, "Bal" (short for *kambal*), can even attest to this fact.

The irony here, however, is that if you asked them six years ago—right around the time when they first met, and sparks weren't flying left and right—if they saw themselves developing a special relationship someday, they would have answered you with blank faces.

But now, if you ask them to define what "KathNiel" is all about, the two will tell you that their relationship is characterized by the most powerful thing in the world:

love.

A story of serendipity

As far as first impressions go, Daniel and Kathryn initially didn't find each other so interesting when they met for the first time on *It's Showtime* back in 2010. The two teen stars were on the show for a guesting but were never formally introduced.

Kathryn recalls that during that time, she and Daniel never uttered a single word to each other—not even so much as a "Hi!"

But the young actress chalks this up to so much shyness getting the better of them.

"Siyempre ako, alam ko namang artista na sila ni Julia [Montes] noon, 'di ba? Pero hindi lang siguro ako nakapag-'Hi' noon, dahil hiyang hiya ako," Daniel explains. "Ako lang din kasi 'yung hindi pa talaga kilala noon, kaya ayoko rin naman magmukhang presko. Pero na-realize kong mali pala 'yung iisipin mong nahihiya ka. Dapat talagang babati ka."

A year later, their paths crossed once again when they got paired on *Growing Up*—the show which was slated to be Kathryn's reunion with Albie Casiño, her leading man in the *Mara Clara* remake. However, because of issues that hounded Albie that time, last minute changes were made and Daniel had taken on Albie's role instead.

Despite being packaged together as a loveteam, Daniel and Kathryn chose to stay out of each other's way, primarily because they mistook the other as being too snooty to even talk to. As a result, the awkwardness between the two reverberated so much in every scene they filmed together.


But even if such were the case, their tandem had still managed to pique the interest of the viewing public. And for Kathryn, the awkwardness between them may have been part of the secret ingredient that helped them gain followers ("Kapag nasa TV kasi, kapag nakikita ko na kapag very innocent and natural 'yung awkwardness, parang I find it cute," Kathryn explains with a smile).

But eventually, Daniel decided to make the bold decision of making the first move and reaching out to his co-star. "Sinabi ko sa sarili ko, 'Bahala na!' Tinanggal

ko na lang 'yung hiya ko sa kanya, kasi siyempre ako 'yung lalaki," Daniel shares. "Pangit naman kung siya pa 'yung unang lalapit. Hindi ko na rin kasi pinabayaan na magkaroon pa ng awkwardness kasi wala namang mangyayari. So eventually, hindi ko na pinapakitang nahihiya ako. Parang normal lang."

Kathryn remembers one of the moments they shared that helped them start getting close. It was during one of their taping days for Growing Up. They were sitting side-by-side in one corner and as they were waiting to be called to start filming for one of their scenes, they started talking about themselves and discovered that they had some things in common.

"After ng usap na 'yun, naging okay na. Nakatulong din 'yung mga kasama namin sa show, kasi parang naging barkada rin kami," she says.

A couple of months later, something happened that is always a big thing between boy and girl—they finally exchanged mobile phone numbers.

After Growing Up concluded, Daniel and Kathryn found themselves being paired once again in the top-rating primetime soap Princess and I. From there, the rest, as they say, is history.

When change happens for the better

Since the onset of their career as one of the country's most sought-after loveteams, Kathryn notes that significant changes have definitely taken place, especially in terms of their relationship with each other—both professionally and personally. She says, "Ngayon, especially last year during our Pangako

Sa'Yo days, doon talaga kami nag-grow together kasi ang daming nangyari. 'Yung phase na 'yun hanggang ngayon, ito 'yung sabi nga namin na the best stage namin, kasi sobrang kilala na namin 'yung isa't isa. On top of that, perhaps one of the things that Kathryn loves about being with Daniel is how he never fails to make her feel secure, especially when they're together. "Feeling ko, basta

Daniel attests to this but more than the changes, the young actor confesses

Daniel Padilla is more than just his "bad boy" image

t has always been in his blood. After all, Daniel John Ford Padilla belongs to one of the most notable showbiz clans in the country. For starters, his father Rommel Padilla is an actor, film producer and politician. His mother Karla Estrada, on the other hand, is an actress, singer and now-toprating morning show host. On top of that, his uncle is iconic action star Robin Padilla.

Given all this, it really is inevitable for the dashing young man to work his magic in the industry.

But in the beginning it is worth noting that Daniel originally wasn't keen on entering showbiz, because he wanted to focus on finishing his studies instead. But as fate would have it, the late manager/discoverer Douglas Quijano discovered him, and brought him to ABS-CBN for a VTR. That led to him being cast on Gimik 2010, a remake of the hit 90s Filipino youth-oriented show. There, he was paired with Julia Montes, but when he scored another role in *Growing Up* the following year, he got the chance to work with Kathryn Bernardo, and that paved the way for the pair's journey to stardom.

Over the years, Daniel has also proven to everyone that he is more than just an actor, for he can also carry a tune, too. In 2012, he released his self-titled debut album, Daniel Padilla, which carried six tracks including the carrier single, "Hinahanap-hanap Kita". Selling more than 10,000 copies in just less than a week, it didn't take long for the album to earn a Gold Record Award and then eventually a Double Platinum Award for its outstanding sales performance.

During that time, industry mover Boy Abunda had made a fearless forecast that in five years, Daniel is going to be one of the biggest stars in Philippine showbiz. Needless to say that the King of Talk has been right in his prediction and it's not difficult to see why. Daniel's unique appeal is so contagious that he never fails to attract hordes of fangirls wherever he stages his shows. Because of his irresistible bad boy charm and also due to the fact that he's a Padilla, he always gets mistakenly tagged as a "babaero". This, as Daniel once revealed in an interview with the *Philippine Star*, is a stereotype that doesn't sit well with him at all, especially



because it was only Kathryn who was ever linked to him since he started his career.

In 2014, he had the chance of realizing his childhood dream of playing basketball professionally when the PBA D-League squad AMA Titans drafted him in their first ever Rookie Draft. However, Daniel displayed maturity when he begged off from the opportunity to make way for more deserving players because as he said, aside from the fact that he isn't equipped enough to make it to the league, his hectic schedule would not also allow him to train very well.

At present, while he is tending on his thriving career, Daniel is also giving his utmost support to his younger brother JC's move to penetrate the music industry. But at the same time, he still doesn't forget that he has another role to play—and that is the defender to all his loved ones. He assumes this role not only around his mother and Kathryn, but also to his baby sister Carmela, as shown when he told Push that he didn't want her to join showbiz just yet, saying, "Hindi pa puwede. Gusto ko kapag matured na si Carmela tapos saka na siya papasok sa industriya."

Kathryn Bernardo's journey to becoming one of showbiz's youngest queens

rior to her foray into showbiz back in 2003, Kathryn Chandria Manuel Bernardo had first been a diligent student at the OB Montessori. But because her interest in showbiz had peaked when she turned six, her parents decided to have her homeschooled instead, so she could chase her dream in the industry.

Kathryn's acting debut was marked when she had taken on the role of the young Cielo on ABS-CBN's It Might Be You. From there, she was able to land her first major role as Maya on Super Inggo. It had served as the springboard for her to book more roles until she landed a permanent spot on the hit kiddie show Goin' Bulilit.

But her portrayal of Mara in the revival of the iconic 90s TV drama Mara Clara had given way to her rapid rise to overwhelming popularity. Since its premiere, the show had remained a tough contender in primetime ratings. As a testament to its success, the show was even nominated in the 2011 Banff World Media Festival under the "Telenovelas and Soap Operas" category, which in turn had determined Kathryn's future as a distinguished actress.

Right after Mara Clara had wrapped up, Kathryn's showbiz career had taken off to greater heights. After 13 years packed with more than 11 movies, lots of TV shows, a long list of awards and various endorsements, Kathryn remains to be one of the most bankable young actresses in the industry today. She has become so influential that she has also been regarded as the "Teen Queen" of Philippine showbiz.

She may seem to have everything in her life right now but it doesn't mean that she will be one to rest on her laurels just yet.

On top of her showbiz commitments, Kathryn is also attending Enderun Colleges, where she is taking up Marketing. "Kino-continue ko talaga siya," she said in an interview. "Mahirap, pero nandiyan 'yung mama ko, para siya magpu-push talaga sa akin, and (yung) Enderun naman—supportive sila. It's team work between me and Enderun, para matapos ng school."

Kathryn may be just 20, but her 13 years' worth of rich showbiz credentials have definitely turned her into a veteran in her own right. ☆



Kathryn appreciate most about their fans—that even if they don't give out everything there is to know about their relationship, there exists an unspoken understanding among their followers. For the young stars, this helps their relationship transcend the showbiz aspects of it into something a lot more real and genuine. This, in turn, has helped them become better in their projects together. Because they enjoy each other's company so much, the scenes just flow naturally and work has stopped feeling like one.

Kathryn and Daniel may remain tight-lipped when it comes to the status of their relationship, but they never shy away from expressing how much they love each other. While Daniel confesses to loving Kathryn so much that it hurts, the *morena* beauty declares that their relationship is the one thing that she wouldn't trade for the world, because nothing will ever come close to what they have.

In addition, the two have been together so much over the years that it has become impossible to disassociate themselves from the other. "Kapag hindi kami magkasama, parang hindi na ako sanay. Parang, 'Saan si DJ?' 'Yun agad tatanungin ko pagbaba ko, tapos hindi ko pa nakikita 'yung sasakyan niya. Kasi nga, I'm not used to it. Nag-uusap din kami parati. Hindi kami 'yung tipong nagsasama lang kasi may trabaho. Kailangan din namin ng oras para sa isa't isa privately, 'yung off-cam," says Kathryn.

As for the times they won't be together, the two have established a set of rules to follow with utmost diligence. 
When asked about what they think the future has in store for them, Daniel smiles and answers that as for the moment, he is happy about the direction they are heading.

And here: he releases what could probably be the biggest, closest confirmation about their relationship—beyond the confines of showbusiness.





nandiyan."


